THE GOALS OF THE PROGRAM:

1. Provide a strong foundation for leaders and ministers in training.
2. Strengthen the local church by equipping future leaders biblically and spiritually.
3. Make this possible totally within the local church.
4. Include each student’s pastor in the recognition of their accomplishment.
5. Provide an apostolic identity with other strongly committed apostolics.
6. Provide an opportunity to pursue further education while remaining within an apostolic framework.

Now, for the first time, pastors can offer fully accredited college courses in their local church. Already scores of pastors have been blessed by the development of these leaders becoming very active in their local churches in evangelism, Bible studies, bus ministry, multi-cultural outreach, and much more.

Courses start in sequence in the fall and spring.

Cost: The program is incredibly inexpensive at a rate of only \$165 per 2-unit course. Therefore, a student can complete 12 credits of accredited college course work for only \$990, which is the typical rate for one college course

* “Accreditation” can be quite confusing as there are numerous accrediting agencies, and most are not without some value. However, the commonly accepted standard for the highest accreditation possible is regional accreditation. Hope International University is regionally accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, one of six regional accrediting agencies in the United States which collaborate to insure the ongoing academic quality of higher education. AST, an institute of HIU, is the only apostolic school in the world with regional accreditation.

APOSTOLIC FOUNDATIONS CERTIFICATE

includes the following courses:

1. Biblical Introduction

Description: In this course, students will discover an overview of Scripture and examine ways in which the whole corpus is integrated to become a single book. Emphasis is placed on the major themes, key Scriptures and major personalities of each book. Students will recognize the Bible as a “Pentecostal” book.

2. Fundamental Doctrine

Description: In this course, students will explore the various doctrines of the Christian faith in order to develop a more well-rounded personal theology upon which to build their ministry. Students will be exposed to the teachings about God’s nature, the Holy Spirit, baptisms, and holiness.

3. Personal and Spiritual Development

Description: This course will explore the nature of spiritual formation in the life of the leader. The calling of God and sending of the minister is examined. In addition, the student will explore the relationship of Spiritual authority and local church governance.

4. Basic Theology

Description: In this course, students will grasp a deeper understanding of basic theological frameworks found in Scripture, including the doctrine of God, God in Christ, the Holy Ghost, the church, and the endtimes.

5. Leadership Development

Description: This course focuses on the dynamics of leading healthy, growing churches and ministries. Students will explore various components of leadership including: 1) meaning of leadership; 2) Spiritual leadership; 3) visionary leadership; 4) managerial leadership; and 5) leadership skills.

6. Intercultural Missions

Description: This course explores basic understandings of the field of missiology and delves into the two basic aspects of the Great Commission: the apostolic and theological mandate. The student will study how to correctly contextualize the Gospel on the foreign field. The student will be expected to put theory into practice during the course.
